

We Support the POWER Act for more Offshore Wind in Maryland

The POWER Act is supported by a unique coalition of labor unions, consumer rights advocates, justice groups, climate focused non-profits, and energy companies. By creating jobs, protecting ratepayers, and reducing pollution, this legislation unites Marylanders in support of offshore wind.



The POWER ACT (SB 781/HB 793) will:

Strengthen labor standards for offshore wind manufacturing, installation, and maintenance



Set a goal for 8.5 gigawatts of **offshore wind by 2031**



Facilitate the construction of a shared transmission infrastructure to **reduce the cost and environmental impact** of future offshore wind projects

Procure approximately one additional gigawatt of offshore wind power in existing lease areas while **protecting ratepayers**
