Virginians Urge Governor Youngkin to Use His Position on FEMA Advisory Board to Improve Rather Than Dismantle the Agency

Dear Governor Youngkin,

We strongly urge you to use your position and influence on the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Review Council to strengthen and improve FEMA's delivery of services. Ahead of what forecasters predict will be an abnormally active hurricane season, Virginians can't afford to be abandoned by the federal government – our communities deserve the certainty that FEMA will be there to support state and local disaster response.

States, including Virginia, cannot and should not have to provide a comprehensive disaster response without federal support. Even though you argue that Virginia can shoulder the burden of a comprehensive disaster response without federal support, you submitted a request on February 16th for an expedited disaster declaration after flooding struck Southwest Virginia. On March 14th, as Richlands residents counted a month of waiting for a federal disaster declaration after the flooding devastated their community, Town Council Member Laura Mollo stated that "A Major Disaster Declaration is important to us, as it will open up desperately needed funding and resources to allow impacted Richlands residents to start to rebuild their lives and regain a semblance of normalcy." With hurricane season in full swing, any advocacy on your part to weaken FEMA's capabilities will only cause similar delays for Virginians and prolong their suffering in extreme weather events.

Virginians depend on coordinated federal, state and local disaster responses that effectively allocate resources to disaster-affected areas. In recent years, Virginia has received federal support from both the Individuals and Households Program (IHP) and the Public Assistance Program (PA). Under your administration, Virginia received \$111,846,163 from PA in 2022 after a severe winter snowstorm; after Hurricane Helene in 2024, Virginia received \$14,688,637 through IHP and \$20,609,439 from PA. This funding provided significant support to Virginians in disaster-affected areas, allowing communities to rebuild and people to repair their homes.

FEMA not only helps Virginia in times of crisis, but also provides key support in mitigating the risk of future disasters by funding resiliency projects. However, the administration's cuts to FEMA's Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities grant program and hazard mitigation grants as part of disaster recovery eliminate major lifelines that protect Virginians from extreme weather. For example, a \$24 million FEMA grant to the city of Portsmouth that would have fortified the Lake Meade Dam and strengthened flood protection was canceled in April. Despite BRIC's funding of this project being described as "a wasteful and ineffective FEMA program" that was "more concerned with political agendas than helping Americans affected by natural disasters," protecting the drinking water of Virginians, especially for times of crisis when essential resources are scarce, is never a waste of money. As Governor, you are charged with fighting against any such accusation against investments in your community, especially those that improve the health of your constituents.

In 2018, a study by the National Institute of Building Sciences found every dollar of federal investment into resiliency projects, taxpayers save \$6. Without federal investments to help shoulder the financial burden, local projects become financially uncertain and, in many cases, unfeasible. Hampton Roads is estimated to require a total of \$40 billion in resilience projects to protect it from rising seas, but questions on costs are already arising: the total cost of Virginia Beach's Flood Protection Program, which is funded through increased real estate taxes, has already doubled from the initial \$567.5 million to \$1 billion, resulting in major concerns about the growing cost burden on the local community. As infrastructure ages and needs grow due to extreme weather, building flood-resilient infrastructure is becoming increasingly expensive. It will be exceedingly difficult for state and local budgets to absorb these additional costs without further raising taxes that often impact the people who need the help the most.

The resilience of our communities' infrastructure isn't a political talking point – it's a key factor in determining whether our cities and towns survive and thrive following a disaster. We urge you to strengthen FEMA by ensuring that:

- FEMA's disaster relief programs are fully funded with adequate staff, guaranteeing immediate and long-term support for disaster survivors.
- The application process for FEMA disaster aid is accessible, easy to use, streamlined, transparent, and understandable to all users.
- Federal disaster aid is deployed based on need, in strict compliance with civil rights laws.
- All who are displaced by disasters are given safe and secure temporary housing near or within their home community.
- Disaster relief is supplied safely, equitably, consistently, and understandably to all who are affected, for as long as they need in order to recover housing, jobs, and property.
- Renters and anyone experiencing homelessness before the disaster quickly get quality, affordable, accessible rental property in safe, quality neighborhoods of their choice.
- All neighborhoods are free from environmental hazards, have quality and accessible public infrastructure, and are safe and resilient.

Communities depend on federal disaster relief in times of crisis. While rebuilding after living through a devastating flood, people in need are not interested in what politicians are discussing in Washington; they want to be able to easily apply for aid and begin rebuilding their lives. Virginians deserve a strong, efficient, and comprehensive federal disaster relief system that leverages local knowledge, federal resources, addresses community-specific issues, and responds to the needs of every Virginian, regardless of who they might be.

We strongly urge you to use your position on the FEMA Review Council and influence to strengthen and improve FEMA's delivery of services for Virginian communities..
